Asbestos removal licence register

Controllers

The Finnish Supervisory Agency's Occupational Safety and Health Department and the Department of Work and Gender Equality of the Ministry of Social Affairs and Health act as joint controllers of the Vati surveillance data system. The Department of Work and Gender Equality of the Ministry of Social Affairs and Health has more restricted access rights as a controller than the other joint controllers.

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The purpose of the processing of personal data and legal basis for the processing

The permit authority maintains an asbestos removal licence register to promote occupational safety and health. The purpose of the register of asbestos removal licences is to promote occupational safety and health, and to allow the processing of licences provided by law and the monitoring of operations of licence holders.

The processing of personal data is based on legislation.

Act on Certain Requirements Concerning Asbestos Removal Work (684/2015), Section 10

Personal data included in the register and special categories of personal data

Special categories of personal data are not processed in the register.

Regular sources of data

The data shall be obtained from asbestos removal licence applications submitted to the occupational safety and health authority.

Disclosure of information

Public information on asbestos removal authorised enterprises shall be transferred once per day to the asbestos removal licence register public information service at the address <http://asbestipurkuluparekisteri.ahp.fi>. The reported email address shall be included in the transferred information. The data is published with the consent of the data subject.

The permit authority may disclose the data, as referred to in sections 10 and 12, by means of a technical interface or by other electrical means, to an authority that requires the data in order to carry out its legal duties.

The data included in the register shall be disclosed in accordance with sections 13 and 16(3) of the Act on the Openness of Government Activities (621/1999).

Transfer of data outside the EU or the EEA

The data shall not be transferred outside the EU or the EEA.

Personal data retention period

Data recorded into the register shall be stored for two years after the validity of the licence or the termination of the licenced operations.

Security of the processing of personal information

Manual material shall be stored on locked premises with restricted access.

IT processed data shall be protected through user group and access rights management, technical protection of servers, physical protection of premises, access control, data communications protection and backup copying of data.

Rights of the data subject

Right of inspection

The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her is being processed. The data subject shall have access to the personal data.

Any data subject who wants to inspect data concerning himself or herself shall submit to the OSH Division of the Regional State Administrative Agency for Western and Inland Finland a request signed by the data subject or similarly authenticated or submit a request in person to the controller.

Right to demand data to be rectified

The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her. The data subject shall have the right to have incomplete personal data completed.

Any data subject who wants to rectify or complete data concerning himself or herself shall submit to the OSH Division of the Regional State Administrative Agency for Western and Inland Finland a request signed by the data subject or similarly authenticated or submit a request in person to the controller.

Other rights related to the processing of personal data

The data subject shall have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (Office of the Data Protection Ombudsman) if the data subject considers that the processing of personal data relating to him or her infringes the EU General Data Protection Regulation.
