The purpose of the processing of personal data and legal basis for the processing

The Finnish Supervisory Agency's Occupational Safety and Health Department processes personal data in their occupational safety and health enforcement activities in order to carry out their legal supervisory duties. The purpose of the processing of personal data and legal basis for the processing are detailed in the sub-register descriptions.

EU General Data Protection Regulation, Article 6(e)

Act on the Openness of Government Activities (621/1999), Section 18

Act on Occupational Safety and Health Enforcement and Cooperation on Occupational Safety and Health at Workplaces, Sections 3, 4, 4a, 4b, 4c, 4d, 4e, 4f

Personal data included in the register and special categories of personal data

Personal data included in the register and special categories of personal data are detailed in the sub-register descriptions.

Regular sources of data

The data shall be collected from OSH Administration's customers, companies, private persons and other authorities in connection with legal supervisory activities of the Occupational Safety and Health Authority. Sources of data are detailed in the sub-register descriptions.

Disclosure of information

Regular disclosure of data is specified in more detail in the sub-register descriptions.

Transfer of data outside the EU or the EEA

The data shall not be transferred outside the EU or the EEA.

Personal data retention period

The personal data retention period is detailed in the sub-register descriptions.

Security of the processing of personal information

The security of the processing of personal information is detailed in the sub-register descriptions.

Rights of the data subject

Right of inspection

The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her is being processed. The data subject shall have access to the personal data.

Any data subject who wants to inspect data concerning himself or herself shall submit to the Finnish Supervisory Agency's Occupational Safety and Health Department a request signed by the data subject or similarly authenticated or submit a request in person to the controller.

Right to demand data to be rectified

The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her. The data subject shall have the right to have incomplete personal data completed.

Any data subject who wants to rectify or complete data concerning himself or herself shall submit to the Finnish Supervisory Agency's Occupational Safety and Health Department a request signed by the data subject or similarly authenticated or submit a request in person to the controller.

Right to erasure

When the processing of personal data is based on the data subject's consent, the personal data can be erased upon request by the data subject. For example, the contact information of a person who has reported a fault or concern at her workplace can be erased from the customer contact data of the Vera surveillance data system upon request by the data subject. However, if the processing of personal data is based on legal supervisory duties of the Occupational Safety and Health Authority the personal data is not usually erased.

Any data subject who wants data concerning himself or herself to be erased shall submit to the Finnish Supervisory Agency's Occupational Safety and Health Department a request signed by the data subject or similarly authenticated or submit a request in person to the controller.

Other rights related to the processing of personal data

The data subject shall have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (Office of the Data Protection Ombudsman) if the data subject considers that the processing of personal data relating to him or her infringes the EU General Data Protection Regulation.
